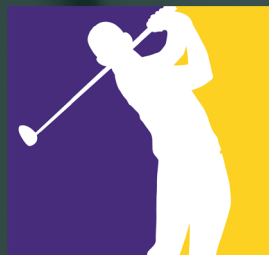

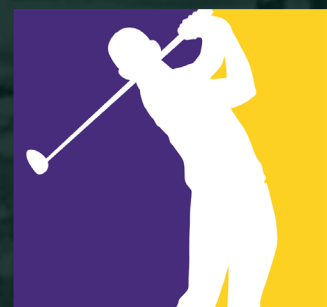

# About The Course

Querbes Park Golf Course has been a cornerstone of Shreveport golf for more than 100 years. Opened in 1924, the course has welcomed legends such as Sam Snead and Hal Sutton while remaining a favorite for local players across generations.

Recent renovations have honored this history while preparing the course for its next century of play. Under the leadership of PGA Professional Nathan Barrow and with design contributions from acclaimed architect Jim Lipe, the front nine has been re-routed and all eighteen greens have been reshaped and sprigged.

The practice area now features an 8,200-square-foot putting and chipping green set in full sun, providing an ideal surface for golfers of every skill level. Championship Bermuda grass throughout the course ensures consistent conditions year-round. Updates to the first and tenth tees, as well as enhanced entry areas, have elevated the overall player experience.

Querbes Park Golf Course stands today as both a community treasure and a premier venue for competitive and recreational play.





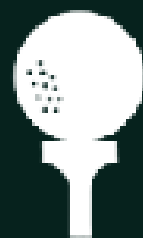
